Directions

Live Power Community Farm is located at 25451 East Lane in Covelo. 707-983-8196. Head North on 101 (the farm is about 3.5 hours north of San Francisco.) After going through Willits, continue north about 10 miles to the exit for Hwy 162, Round Valley, Covelo Road. Turn right. Follow Covelo Road for about 30 miles into the valley and Covelo itself. Just before the end of town, just past the Tri City Bank, is East Lane. Turn right. Go 1.5 miles. The farm is on the right, the mailbox #25451 is on the left. There's a 2-story white house with green trim, and a barn roof with solar panels.
