- Breeding program supervision;
- Manure management and collection;
- Transport to proprietary slaughter facility;
- Management and maintenance of feeding and watering systems;
- Maintenance of swine housing and equipment;
- Management of production records;
- Maintenance of strict bio-security measures;

This position will be responsible for:

- Care, accountability, protection and well being of all animals in the swine program, as well as other species within Belcampo's multi-species farming system as circumstance dictates.
- Upkeep of the fixed and mobile facilities associated with swine production and animal husbandry.
- Supervising seasonal and or fulltime staff.
